Anatomy of a Bird Definitions

Use these definitions to match them to the bird!

Back: Rear part of the body, from the head to the rump

Beak: Hard, pointed structure on the front of a birds face. Used to eat, peck, or groom

Belly: Lower area on the front of a bird, beneath the breast

Breast: Front part of the birds body, below the neck

Head: Upper part of the birds body, contains their brain, eyes, and beak

Leq: Birds have two legs for walking

Nape: Back of the neck

Nostril: On the beak, used to breathe

Kump: Lower back, hind parts

Side: Left and right positions on the body, underneath the wings

Tail: An extension at the back of the birds body, helps in flying and attracting mates

Throat: Front of the neck

Wing: Located on both sides of the birds body. Used for flying
